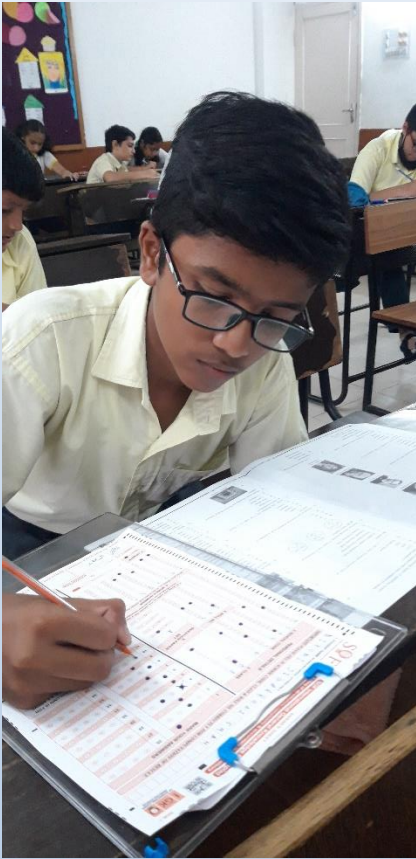
September 10, 2022 (Investiture Ceremony)
