LANGUAGE SKILL

Writing Letters "A to Q"

Last week, we introduced letter "Q q". To revise the concept of all the letters up to Q, we gave them chalk and asked them to write letters A to Q on their study table. We also wrote on board to guide them how to write and at the same time we revised phonics sound of the same letters.



NUMBER READINESS

Numeral Match Dice

To begin the session, we sang 'Count 1 to 10" song to indicate that they have to learn about numerals. In this activity they had to roll the dice and count the dots facing up and another child would show the wooden cutout of the same number. Children enjoyed the session.






CONCEPT






LANGUAGE SKILLS






CONCEPT

Water Cycle

This week, our tiny tots learnt about Water Cycle. We made our kids understand by visuals about water cycle. We informed them that heat from the sun causes water to **evaporate** from oceans, lakes and streams. Evaporation occurs when liquid water on earth's surface turns into water vapor in our atmosphere. As the water vapor rises higher, the cool air of the atmosphere causes the water vapor to turn back into liquid water, creating clouds. This process is called **condensation.** When a cloud becomes full of liquid water, it falls from the sky as rain or snow - also known as **precipitation**. Rain and snow then fill lakes and streams, and the process starts all over. Children enjoyed this concept.


