There were a corners where they displayed Pronunciation of words. The objective of this corners was to help students pronounce the words correctly.



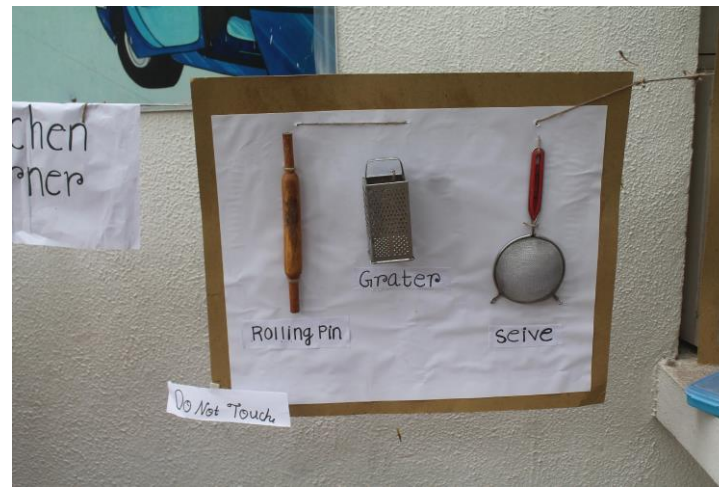
Adjective & Preposition Corner

Homophone is a word that is pronounced the same as another word but has a different spelling and meaning. To explain our students' homophone, a corner was set up where different homophomes were set up.



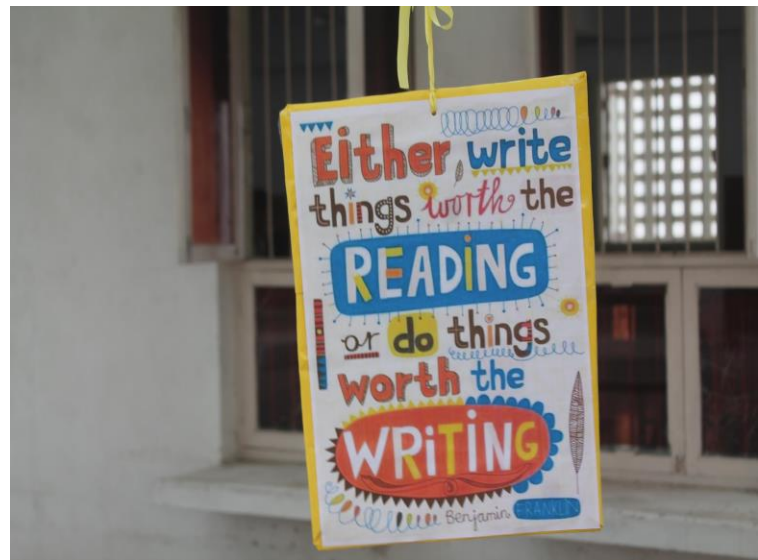
Interesting facts about English language
