**Gratitude is a powerful catalyst for happiness. It's the spark that lights a fire of joy in your soul.**

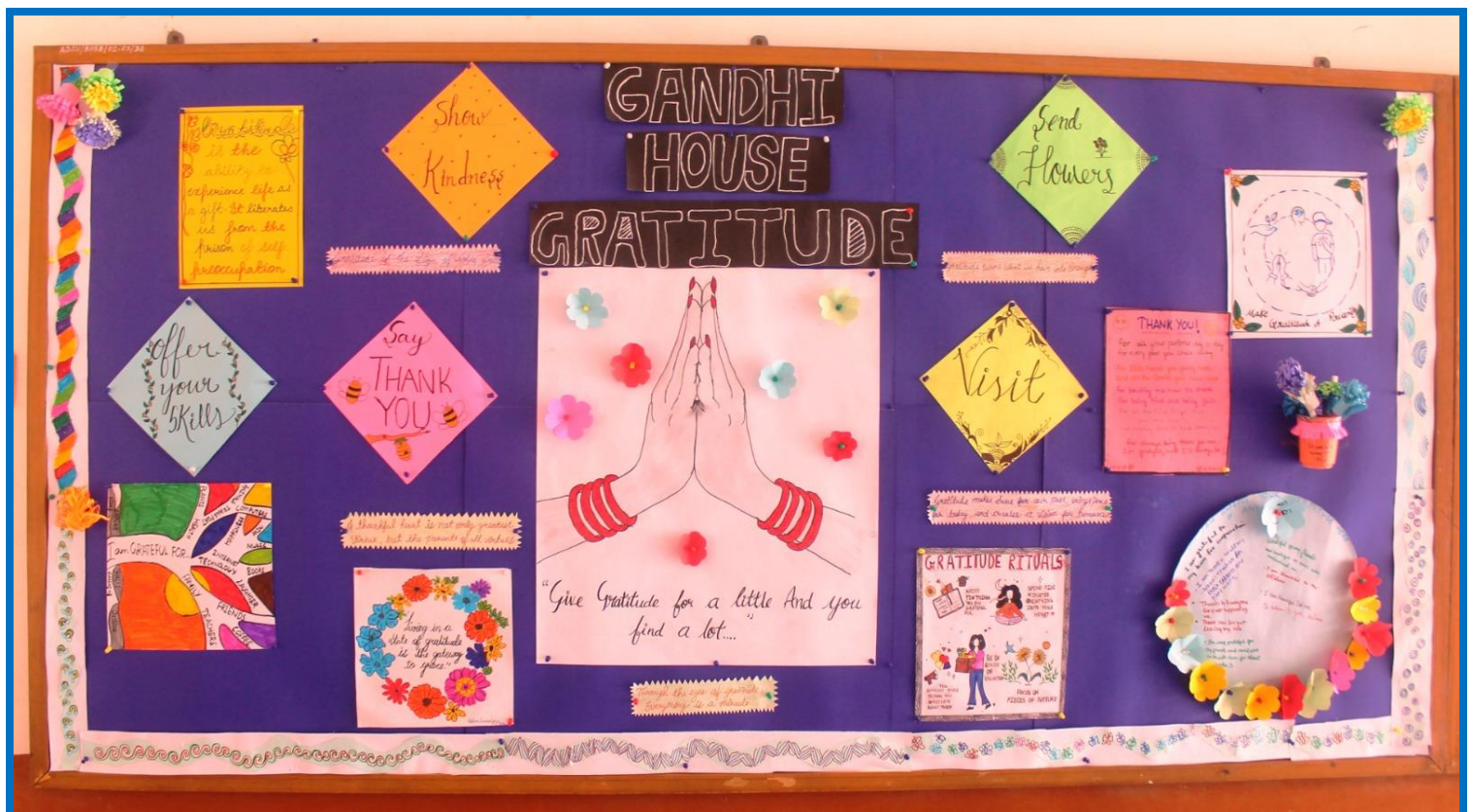
