Rather than testing rote learning, it tests how well skill and concepts underlying the school syllabus have been learnt by the student. The test provides information on the strengths and weaknesses of individual students.

Adani Public School conducts various Olympiad examinations for the overall development of students. This year 23 students appeared for this examination. The examination was held on December 15, 2023 in school premises during regular school timings. The examination was conducted successfully under the supervision of the teachers.
