Olympiad examinations at school level are competitive examination, based on the school syllabus, which are conducted through various independent organizations. These exams give exposure to students about competition and make them ready to face any competitive challenge that would be thrown open to them in the future.

The International Mathematics Olympiad (SOF IMO) is an annual event conducted by the Science Olympiad Foundation (SOF) to evaluate the mathematical abilities of students from Grades 1 to 12. The SOF Olympiad exposes students to a challenging curriculum, encouraging them to develop their creativity, logical reasoning, and critical thinking skills, while building their self-confidence in a competitive environment from an early age. The top 5% students who qualify for the IMO level-1 will be eligible to participate in the IMO level-2 competition.

This year 465 students appeared for this examination. The examination was held on 30th October, 2023 in school premises during regular school timings.
