



Jolly Phonics Session

"Phonics is the key that opens the door to reading."

Jolly Phonics is a synthetic phonics scheme that teaches children the alphabetic code of English. The objective of the Jolly Phonics session was to introduce and reinforce phonemic awareness and early reading skills among young learners.

The training of Jolly Phonics was conducted for Foundational Stage (Prep – 2) on June 20, 2024 (Monday) by Ms. Milan Sampat.

Main pointers of training were:

Introduction to Phonics Sounds: The session began with a lively introduction to basic phonics sounds using the Jolly Phonics methodology. Participants were engaged through visual aids and interactive activities to associate sounds with corresponding letters.

Blending and Segmenting Practice: Following the introduction, participants engaged in blending and segmenting exercises. This involved combining individual sounds to form simple words and breaking down words into their constituent sounds.
