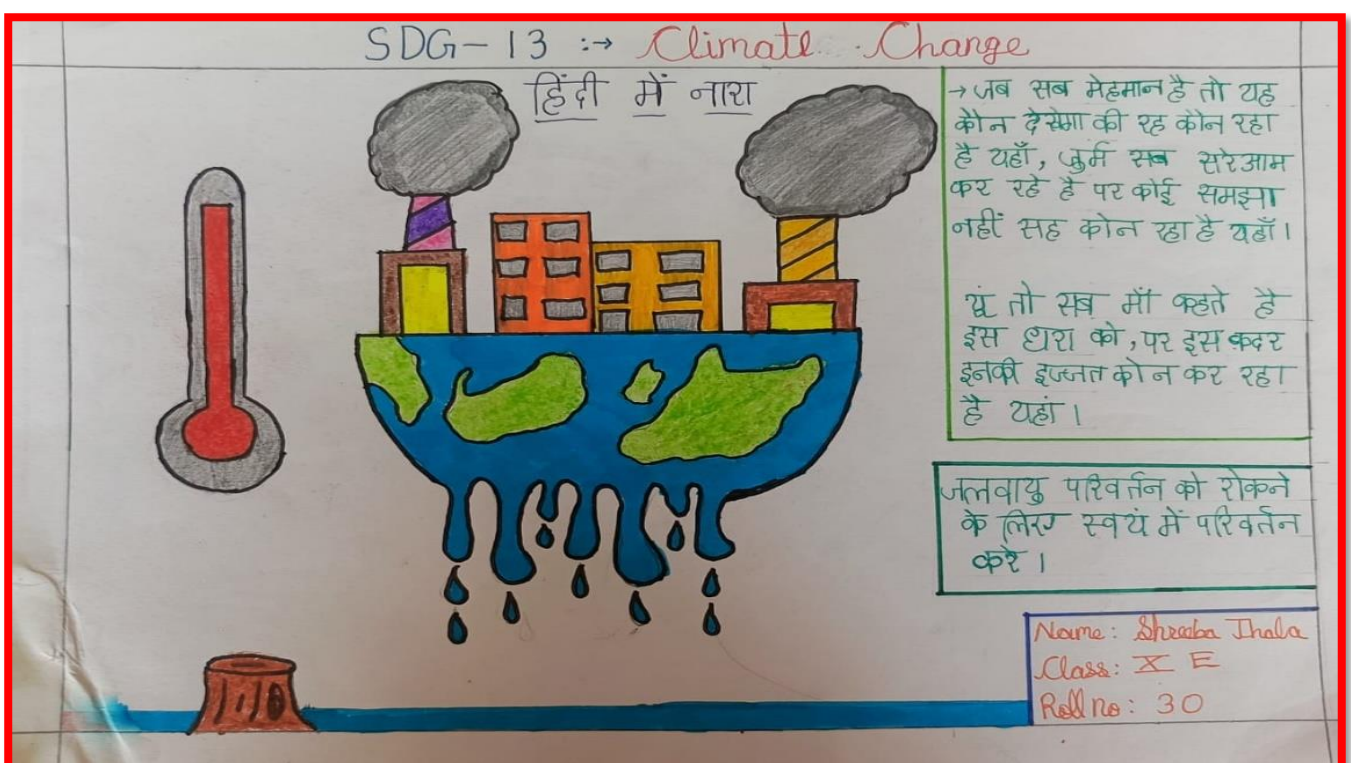
Measures we can take to combat climatic action: (18 June 2024)
