The training session of NCrF was conducted by Principal Dr. Mayur Patadia and Coordinator Mr. Parimal Parmar. It was held on June 26, 2024. **The objective of the credit point system is to foster positive behaviour among children and make them responsible citizen. It also aims to inculcate good values in our students.**

This Framework will allow students to earn credits by demonstrating their knowledge & skills in a variety of subjects. Credits will be deposited in Academic Bank of Credit(ABC) linked to Digi Lockers. It will be independent of marks. Notional Learning Hours in a year will be 1200. Total Credit per subject in a year will be 40. No credit will be allowed if child fails in the subject or does not appear for assessment.

- Total learning hours
- Comprehending the credit Allocation
- Time allocation per subject
