
- Grow any three to five plants, herbs, or vegetables at their home.

- Click photographs of your tasks done, Prepare a Vlog / Diary / Scrape Book of your vacation activities.
















May

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


Measures we can take to combat climatic action: (18 June 2024)

Climate change refers to long term shifts in temperature and weather patterns. It affects all regions around the world. Climate actions refer to efforts taken to combat climate change and it's impacts.


Science teachers shared with students' consequences and some of the factors responsible for climate action. They also discussed the measures that they can practice in their daily lives at home, school and outside.


Slogan Writing Competition – Grade 1 to 12 (19 June 2024)




Review by Jyoti Samkariya: Her review highlighted the following key points:
