## National Credit Framework Training (NCrF)

**June 26, 2024**

Adani Public School fosters positive behaviour in students. National Credit Framework (NCrF) is a credit system that aims to align education and skilling. The training session of NCrF was conducted by Principal Dr. Mayur Patadia and Coordinator Mr. Parimal Parmar. It was held on June 26, 2024. **The objective of the credit point system is to foster positive behaviour among children and make them responsible citizen. It also aims to inculcate good values in our students.**

This Framework will allow students to earn credits by demonstrating their knowledge & skills in a variety of subjects. Credits will be deposited in Academic Bank of Credit(ABC) linked to Digi Lockers. It will be independent of marks. Notional Learning Hours in a year will be 1200. Total Credit per subject in a year will be 40. No credit will be allowed if child fails in the subject or does not appear for assessment.

They further guided teachers on the following points:

- What is National learning hour?
- Credit base as per NCrF
- Total learning hours
- Comprehending the credit Allocation
- Time allocation per subject

Adani Public School will implement the National Credit Framework (NCrF) for class IX.

Positive behaviour credits and negative behaviour deductions will be calculated in both the academic terms and would be reflected in the student's annual holistic progress card.

# STEM Training at Mundra

July 29, 2024 & July 31, 2024

**“STEM is not a class you teach it’s a culture you build.” – Chris Woods**

The Adani Foundation has announced a collaboration with the National Institute of Education (NIE), a part of Nanyang Technological University (NTU), Singapore, to develop and implement a comprehensive STEM Leadership Program. The initiative, facilitated by the Temasek Foundation (Singapore), will see 42 teachers from seven Adani Foundation schools trained as master trainers to promote STEM leadership in India. The program will include a baseline study of STEM education, the development of an Integrated STEM Curriculum Framework, and the construction of STEM Curricular Leadership through online and in-person workshops. Master trainers will also share their learnings at the three-day international conference in April 2025.

The third phase of the training was held at Adani Public School Mundra from July 29, 2024 to July 31, 2024. It was a good learning experience for the trainees. The resource team from Singapore was given a warm traditional welcome by the Bagpiper band, NCC Army and Navy cadets. Special Stolls of Kutch were presented to the guests. Ms. Ami Shah (Director of APS), Mr. George Thomas (Director, Education), Dr. Kavita Nagpal (Chief Academic Officer), Ms. Meeta Jadeja (Incharge Principal) and Dr. Renu Patidar (Vice Principal) gave a formal welcome to the resource team. - Lesson Plan on Water Scarcity –Collecting Water in Arid Region was shared.

Through the lesson plan they gave an example of how to conduct the activity in the class with the students. In the lesson plan they presented the problem and guided teachers to construct the persona. After the explanation of the lesson plan the teachers were provided with the materials to make the prototype for convenient, clean and constitent source for villagers. The rubrics were provided to them beforehand to allow them to plan their prototype and pitch according to the expectations. The prototype was then tested and teachers were asked to present their prototype. The resource team then helped the teachers to reflect on the process and prototype. It helped learners think deeply, analyse and make informed decisions.



### Day 3 ( July 31, 2024)

On the last day teachers of different schools planned their lessons in groups and conducted it in different classes. STEM Team observed the lessons of the teachers and gave their feedback to them. Teachers also shared their reflections about the lesson. **STEM Team and teachers from ADANI Schools Spectrum appreciated students participation and curiosity.** Students also filled the feedback form shared with them. Overall it was an interactive session where teachers and students actively participated and gave their best.
