Mathematics is an important tool for navigating and understanding the world around us. Its importance extends beyond academics to everyday life, influencing personal growth, career opportunities and societal progress. Aryabhata Ganit Challenge 2024 is a national level math competition in India, conducted by the Aryabhata Ganit Challenge Organization (AGC). **The objective is to promote mathematical thinking, problem – solving skills, and logical reasoning among students.**

CBSE Board has organized Aryabhata Ganit Challenge (AGC) 2024 to enhance mathematical abilities among students through rigorous assessment. It was held at national level wherein all the leading schools of India participated. **The AGC will be conducted in two phases - a pen and paper test at the school level and an online computer – based test at national level.**

APS conducted the first phase (pen and paper test) for the students of grade VIII to X on September 6, 2024 under the supervision of in – charge teacher Mr. Shiva Naripalli. Altogether 211 students participated in it. Questions on the history of Mathematics, logical thinking and higher order thinking were included to check the critical thinking skills of the students. It aims to focus on the extent to which children are able to apply Mathematics to their daily life.
