Navratri Celebration October 3, 2024 to October 10, 2024



School Field Trip – Class XI October 21, 2024

With the purpose of expanding students' educational travels in profound ways, Adani Public School, Mundra, had arranged a field trip for Class XI to Renewable Energy Park in Khavda, Kutch on Monday, October 21, 2024. Renewable Energy Park is expanding at unbelievable speed and will be soon becoming the world's largest power facility. The children understood the importance of renewable energy and sustainable development at the plant.

109 students from Class XI (Commerce and Science) along with their teachers went to the field trip. The children and their teachers left Mundra at 8 a.m. for Khavda using the school transport. On arrival at Khavda they were warmly greeted by Renewable Energy Park staff.

Here are some insights of the field trip...

- The representatives informed them about Adanis' strategy, which included Adani Power and Adani Green Energy supplying 6,600 MW of hybrid solar and thermal power to Maharashtra.
- The PowerPoint presentation informed students that the energy created would be distributed across the country. According to a 2022-2023 comparison assessment, the plant will be capable of producing 30 GW of energy by 2030.
- The lecture also demonstrated the issues encountered in the region.
- It was demonstrated to the students how energy is generated through the use of both solar and wind power at that specific time.
- Solar molecules are cleaned and installed using robots.
- In total, there are three camps: an airship, a communication tower, and a RO water plant.

International Math Olympiad October 22, 2024


Olympiads whether national or international, are widely regarded as one of the most challenging exams. These exams give exposure to students about competition and make them ready to face any competitive challenge that they will confront in future.

Th International Mathematics Olympiad (SOF IMO) is an annual event conducted by the Science Olympiad Foundation (SOF) to evaluate the mathematical abilities of students from classes I to XII.

The IMO is a prestigious Math competition for students worldwide. The primary objectives of this exam are to challenge and encourage mathematically gifted students. It also promotes problem solving skills, critical thinking and logical reasoning. The top 5% students who qualify for the IMO level-1 will be eligible to participate in the IMO level-2 competition.

Adani Public School conducted the International Math Olympiad on October 22, 2024. This year 581 students appeared for this examination from classes I to XII. The examination was conducted in school premises during regular school timings under the supervision of teachers.
